HANDI-CARD PROGRAM



MACOG offers half-fares on the Interurban Trolley fixed route service to qualifying persons with physical or cognitive disabilities.

A Handi-Card is an identification card for disabled persons who can use the Interurban Trolley, but with difficulty, to receive a discounted fare.

USING THE HANDI-CARD

Anyone who wishes to use the Interurban Trolley Handi-Card must apply, be found eligible, and receive their card prior to using the Handi-Card discounted fare. Discounted fare is available during non-peak hours and must have a picture ID.

5:00 am - 7:00 am

11:00 am - 3:00 pm

6:00 pm - 7:00 pm

*Please note: if you have a **MEDICARE** card, you may use your card as identification for reduced fares; a **HANDI-CARD** is not needed. **MEDICAID** cards, social security and **MEDICARE** disability checks are not valid for reduced fares.*
